RCI Ontario Chapter Annual General Meeting

RCI Ontario Chapter held their annual general meeting on [Wednesday, February 13, 2013](#) at the Brampton Golf Club. With 56 members in attendance plus proxies submitted, the meeting had quorum. Joel Dandele, President, chaired the meeting.

Committee reports for 2012 were presented. The 2012 financial statements were presented by Treasurer Don Marks. Membership Director Bryan Fishburn reported that the Chapter had increased membership in 2012 by 35 members from 266 to 301.
